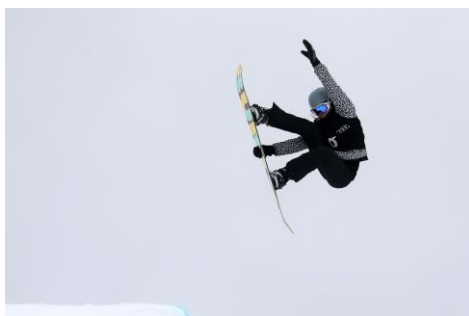


## Emily Arthur – Snowboard
